Need Financial Help? - Tazwood Community Services, Inc.'s Community Services Block Grant has funding for Tazewell and Woodford Counties for the following programs: emergency rent payment due to eviction or homelessness, emergency water bill payment to prevent shut-off, prescription program, emergency dental program, optical program, hearing aid assistance, care repair assistance. A person's gross income must be at or below these federal guidelines for the previous 90 days: 1 in house - \$3,581, 2 in house - \$4,846, 3 in house - \$6,103, 4 in house - \$7,359, 5 in house - \$8,615, 6 in house - \$9,871, 7 in house - \$11,128, 8 in house - \$12,384, 9 in house - \$12,698.
