**Mission Appeal** - Father Deus-Dedit Byabato, a Chaplain at OSF St. Mary's Medical Center in Galesburg, will be visiting us the weekend of July 27/28, 2013 for our annual Mission Collection. We will be taking up a mission collection for the completion of Holy Cross Church and Rectory in Father's home diocese of Bukoba, Tanzania, East Africa. Please be as generous as possible to this very needy cause.

The cost of finishing the rectory will be approximately \$90,000. The materials are expensive and then everything that is used in the construction needs to be shipped a great distance. This, of course, adds to the over-all cost. The Holy Cross parishioners contribute by making the bricks themselves. Checks can be made out to St. Luke and then one check will be forwarded to Fr. Byabato.

These methods are based on observation of the naturally occurring signs and symptoms of the fertile and infertile phases. NFP is the healthy, effective, and morally acceptable family planning method. No drugs, devices, or surgical procedures are used to avoid pregnancy. NFP reflects the dignity of the human person within the context of marriage and family life, promotes openness to life, and recognizes the value of the child. By respecting the love-giving and life-giving natures of marriage, NFP can enrich the bond between husband and wife. This would be a good time to learn more about NFP and to trust in the Lord God; He has a perfect plan for your marriage, your life.
