Speaker - Bonnie Engstrom (a St. Luke parishioner) will be speaking about her son's alleged miraculous healing through the intercession of Venerable Fulton J Sheen on Tuesday, February 26th at 6:30 p.m. In 2010 Bonnie's son, James Fulton, was a stillborn. After being without a pulse for 61 minutes, James' heart began to beat though it was believed that he would die again or be severely disabled. Amazingly, two years later, James is completely normal and his healing is being considered by the Vatican as the miracle needed for Fulton Sheen's beatification. Along with sharing her family's story Bonnie will also discuss the canonization process and provide some background on who Venerable Sheen is.
