**Divine Mercy Novena** - The Divine Mercy Novena begins on Good Friday and ends the Sunday after Easter which is Divine Mercy Sunday. During the Solemn Novena leading to Divine Mercy Sunday, the Chaplet of Divine Mercy should be offered for that day's intentions. The different souls prayed for on each day of the novena are:

Day 1 (Good Friday) - All mankind, especially sinners

Day 2 (Holy Saturday) - The souls of priests and religious

Day 3 (Easter Sunday) - All devout and faithful souls

Day 4 (Easter Monday) - Those who do not believe in Jesus and those who do not yet know Him

Day 5 (Easter Tuesday) - The souls of separated brethren

Day 6 (Easter Wednesday) - The meek and humble souls and the souls of children

Day 7 (Easter Thursday) - The souls who especially venerate and glorify Jesus' mercy

Day 8 (Easter Friday) - The souls who are detained in purgatory;

Day 9 (Easter Saturday) - The souls who have become lukewarm.
