The minutes of the parish council meetings are published after they have been approved at the next meeting. Due to the lack of a quorum, there was no parish council meeting in March.

Minutes: St. Luke Parish Council Meeting, January 19, 2013

After opening the meeting with prayer, minutes from the 11/19/2012 meeting were approved after corrections were made.

Pastor's Report: Larry Quenette was hired to initiate design work for a space for the baptismal font, an accessible confessional, a new cry room, septarium, and an adoration room at a cost of \$2,400.00. Foyer Replacement of carpeting would be part of the projects.

Families Helping Families will be held on January 20th. Ed Hoekstra is helping Fr. Radosevich renovate the Ladies room in the basement. Some of the work being done includes: undercoating the walls with water sealing paint, installing foam strips and foam board, vapor barrier, drywall, wainscoting, chair rails, trim and flooring. Ceiling tile, lighting, and the sink will be replaced. The new diaper changing station will be installed, and the exiting station will be moved to the men's room.

Other work was being performed in the basement. Ceiling tiles were replaced in the hallway locations and some malfunctioning fluorescent lights were replaced with LED lights. The room divider at the end of the hall was removed and replaced with a curtain.

Ladies Guild: The Guild donated \$500.00 toward the ladies room renovation project. 15 ladies attended the Christmas party at Maria's in Washington.

The next meeting will be held on the second Tuesday in March to plan the next salad luncheon.

Men's Club: The fish fry will be held on March 22nd.

Youth Group: Debbie Drennan is leading the youth group.

Future projects that have already been identified include:

Carpet replacement for the vestibule (on hold), front entrance door and trim replacement, replace downstairs carpeting, replace downstairs lighting, paint basement wall, replace landscaping timbers around the church, repaint stucco on outside of building (spring 2013, approx. \$540), restripe parking lot, replace power line to shed, commercial dishwasher for kitchen.
