The cost of finishing the rectory will be approximately \$90,000. The materials are expensive and then everything that is used in the construction needs to be shipped a great distance. This, of course, adds to the over-all cost. The Holy Cross parishioners contribute by making the bricks themselves. Checks can be made out to St. Luke and then one check will be forwarded.

St. Luke Support for St. Jude - The marathon to support the work of St. Jude Hospital in Memphis is quickly approaching and we in Eureka have an opportunity to support the runners who are coming from Bloomington/Normal. The runners and their support vehicles will make a stop at the Eureka Lake Pavilion around 1:00 pm on Saturday, Aug. 3rd. Minutes: St. Luke Parish Council Meeting, May 18, 2013

Present: Father Radosevich, Peg Sprague, Larry Robinson, Floyd Heffren, Joe Newkirk, Tom Eckert, Marcia Brogly, Rick Twait

After opening the meeting with prayer, minutes from the 01/19/2013 meeting were approved after corrections were made.

Pastor's Report: Renovations to the downstairs restrooms were completed. Work on the hallway is completed, and the preschool room was renovated. Around \$2,700 is needed to offset the costs.

The ciboria was refinished for \$420.00 .

Suggestions for upstairs renovations were sent to Larry Quenettee, with no response to date.

The stairs were renovated at the Newman Center. The treads were replaced, spindles and bannister were refinished, and replacement carpet was purchased.

Funds were donated for patio furniture at the Newman Center. Rebate coupons from the purchase were used to buy a new dual charcoal/gas grill.

The lawn mower broke down and new mower was purchased for \$6,000. The Men's Club will dispose of the broken mower.

ParishSoft web based accounting software will now be used throughout the entire Diocese. The \$15.00 per month fee will result in about the same costs as with the existing software. An accountant will be hired temporarily to take care of payroll and other transactions while the transition to ParishSoft is completed.

Eucharistic minister training will be starting. The three year terms of current ministers expired. Tom Eckert will continue to serve the homebound. Ten to 12 people will be recruited, trained, mandated and commissioned.

The current Bible study class will end in June. A possible subject for next fall's classes is the Catechism.

Administration: Elections for 2 new parish council terms will be held.

Building and Grounds: The wood at the entranceway was clad with metal for \$800. New electrical cable to the garage was tabled, due to the unforeseen expenses of the replacement mower. Anne Dwyer started work on the flowers.

Men's Club: Tom Eckert will be the representative. A fish or chicken fry will be held this fall. The Men's Club purchased an on-demand water heater to replace the conventional unit that failed.

Youth Group: The Youth Group is raising money to attend the March for Life in Washington, D.C., and will have a bake sale on June 8th. The group helped work on the flower beds.

New Business: Father Radosevich would like to start a new fundraiser for improvements and renovations. It was decided that sandwiches, drinks and chips would be sold at the July 4th activities at Eureka Lake Park. General planning details were made and committees were formed.

Future projects that have already been identified include:

Carpet replacement for the vestibule (on hold), front entrance door and trim replacement , replace downstairs carpeting, replace downstairs lighting, paint basement wall, replace landscaping timbers around the church, repaint stucco on outside of building (spring 2013, approx. \$540), restripe parking lot, replace power line to shed, commercial dishwasher for kitchen.
