The parish council meets on the third Saturday of the odd number months (January, March, May, July, September and November). The meetings are immediately following the 4:00 PM vigil Mass. Some of those being elected this time will be two year terms and some will be to complete positions that have been vacated or were not filled last year and will have a one year term. As accordance with the parish constitution:

The purpose of this Pastoral Council shall be:

Section 1 – To serve as a consultative body to assist and advise the Pastor and Trustees in the administration of the parish, and to represent the laity in matters that concern the parish spiritually and temporally. The Christian faithful are free to make known to the pastors of the church their needs, especially spiritual ones, and their desires (Canon 212 2).

Section 3 – To recommend short and long range goals and priorities to guide the parish toward effective ministry; to plan, develop and implement programs necessary to accomplish our mission objectives.

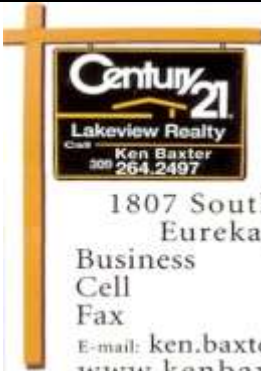
