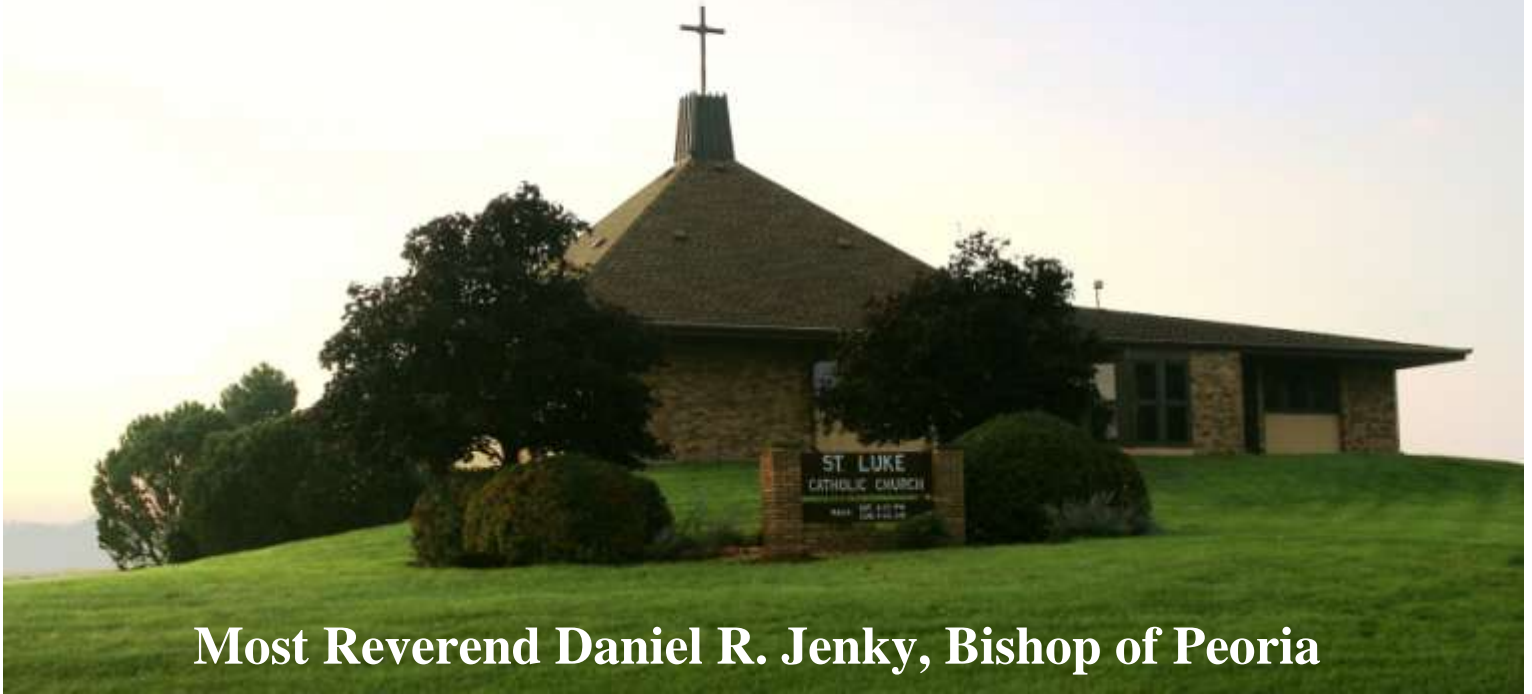

**Contribution Deadline** – In order for us to end our calendar year and get everything recorded, Sunday, December 27<sup>th</sup> is the cut off for 2015 contributions for tax purposes. Any contributions received after this date will be posted on the following year.

**Required Minimum Distribution** - There is good news if you have reached age 70 1/2 and you would like to help St. Luke's. If you have an IRA, the government requires you to take out a certain minimum amount each year and be subject to federal tax. However, the law allows you to donate this amount directly to St. Luke's during 2015 and have it distributed free of federal income tax! 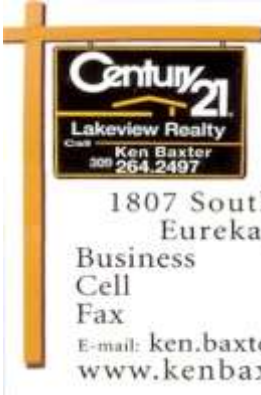
