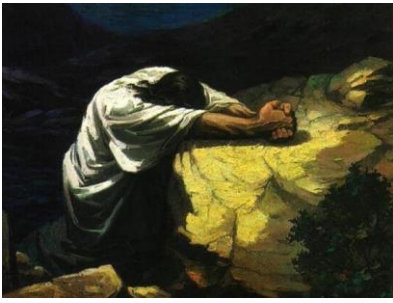

Crucified with Christ Through the Sorrowful Mysteries of the Rosary

Pope Francis describes Lent as a “journey of spiritual renewal in the footsteps of Christ.” It is a time when we are invited to re-examine our relationship with Christ and grow into a deeper, more meaningful relationship with him. This Lenten Season, St. Joseph’s, through the altar decorations, invites you to take this journey through meditating on the Sorrowful Mysteries of the Rosary. These mysteries allow us an opportunity to complete Jesus’ passion and death. We are reminded that Christ offered His very life to save us from our sins.

The first Sorrowful Mystery: **The Agony in the Garden** “And He came out and proceeded as was his custom over the ravine of the Kidron, to the Mount of Olives; and the disciples also followed him (Jn 18:1). They came to a garden, a place named Gethsemane; and He said to them: “Pray that you may not enter into temptation.” (Lk 22:40).

Jesus speaks to us today just as he did to his disciples while at the garden. His request is the same “pray that you may not enter into temptation.” How do we respond to his request? Do we try to control our troubles, concerns, pain, and temptations on our own or do we learn from Jesus’ pain, suffering and prayer in the garden and offer them to the Father and ask, not ours, but “thy will be done”.

Year of St. Joseph

Pope Francis announced from December 8, 2020 to December 8, 2021 will be the year of St. Joseph. This was done because it marks the 150th anniversary of the saint’s proclamation as patron of the Universal Church. Pope Francis hopes that, “every member of the faithful, following his example, may strengthen their life of faith daily in the complete fulfillment of God’s will.”
