Crucified with Christ

Through the Sorrowful Mysteries of the Rosary THE SCOURGING AT THE PILLAR

Then Pilate said, "I find no guilt in this man. I will therefore chastise Him and release Him." (Luke 23:4, 16) Pilate then took Jesus and had Him scourged. (John 19:1) Oppressed and condemned, He was taken away, a man of suffering. (Isa. 53:8, 3) Though He was harshly treated, He submitted, like a lamb led to the slaughter. (Isa. 53:7)

Our "journey of spiritual renewal in the footsteps of Christ" takes us to the pillar. Pilate questioned Jesus: "Are you the king of the Jews?" When Jesus said, "Mine is not a kingdom of this world..." (John 18:36-37) Pilate did not understand.

When Jesus said: "I came into the world for this; to bear witness to the truth; and all who are on the side of truth listen to My Voice." Pilate scornfully replied, "Truth? What is truth?" (John 18:38)

Pilate's heart was cold and hardened. He was more concerned with pleasing the crowd, his earthly status and his popularity, then he was at finding the truth Jesus had to offer. He ordered Jesus to be bound and mercilessly beaten. The prophesy of Isaiah was fulfilled: "He

was wounded for our iniquities; He was bruised for our sins."

How often do we have hearts like Pilate? How often are we more concerned with our earthly status and popularity, then living as Jesus taught? How often do we forget the Truth that Jesus spoke of?

As we continue our Lenten journey, let us ask the Holy Spirit to continue to work in our hearts and prepare in them a place for Jesus. May we also have the courage, strength, and perseverance that Jesus continues to show us on his journey to the cross.

That others may be preferred to me in everything,

That others may become holier than I, provided that I may
become as holy as I should,
