Along with sharing her family's story Bonnie will also discuss the canonization process and provide some background on who Venerable Sheen is. The talk is sponsored by the St. Patrick Elizabeth Ministry and will be held at the Knights of Columbus Hall on the square in Washington. Admission is free and families are welcome, though the topic may be more appropriate for ages 12 and up.

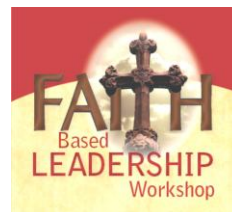
