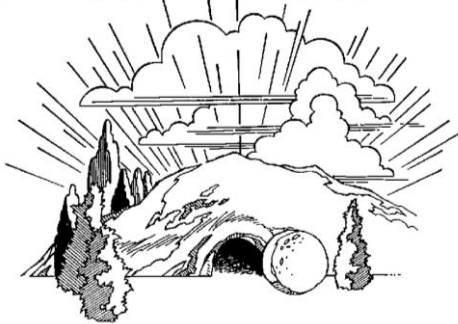
**Coffee & Donuts** - We are in need of someone to assist with coffee & donuts on Sunday, April 7. If you can help, please call Marcia at 467-4855.
